Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The bill prohibits a political subdivision from requiring a license or permit for a business, other than a business at which potentially hazardous food is sold, that is operated by a person under the age of 18 and that is operated only occasionally.

The local fiscal estimate is indeterminate as the department does not have detailed data on license or permit revenue related to businesses occasionally operated by a person under the age of 18. In 2022, revenues for business and occupation licenses total \$60.76 million.

The department does not have any administrative costs.
