REFERENCE BUREAU CORRECTIONS

Assembly Bill 574

In enrolling, the following corrections were made:

1. Page 3, line 5: after that line insert:

“**SECTION 1s.** 73.0301 (1) (d) 6. of the statutes, as affected by 2023 Wisconsin Act (Senate Bill 668), is amended to read:

73.0301 (1) (d) 6. A license or certificate of registration issued by the department of financial institutions, or a division of it, under ss. 138.09, 138.12, 138.14, 202.12 to 202.14, 202.22, 203.03, 217.05, 218.0101 to 218.0163, 218.02, 218.04, 218.05, 224.72, 224.725, 224.93 or under subch. IV of ch. 551.”.

****NOTE: Items 1., 2., 3., 7., and 8. merge this bill with 2023 Senate Bill 668 contingent upon 2023 Senate Bill 668 being enacted.

2. Page 3, line 10: after that line insert:

“**SECTION 2s.** 108.227 (1) (e) 6. of the statutes, as affected by 2023 Wisconsin Act (Senate Bill 668), is amended to read:

108.227 (1) (e) 6. A license or certificate of registration issued by the department of financial institutions, or a division of it, under ss. 138.09, 138.12, 138.14, 202.12 to 202.14, 202.22, 203.03, 217.05, 218.0101 to 218.0163, 218.02, 218.04, 218.05, 224.72, 224.725, 224.93 or under subch. IV of ch. 551.”.

3. Page 4, line 3: after that line insert:

“**SECTION 3m.** 138.09 (1a) (c) of the statutes, as created by 2023 Wisconsin Act (this act), is renumbered 138.09 (1c) (a) 7.”.

4. Page 4, line 4: delete “of the statutes is amended” and substitute “(c) of the statutes is created”.

5. Page 4, line 5: delete lines 5 to 8 and substitute:

“138.14 (3) (c) Providers of earned wage access services required to be licensed under s. 203.03 (1).”.

****NOTE: Items 4. and 5. merge the treatment of s. 138 (3) by this bill with 2023 Wisconsin Act 37.

6. Page 9, line 23: delete “policymaking” and substitute “policy-making”.

7. Page 20, line 2: after that line insert:

“**SECTION 7s.** 220.02 (3) of the statutes, as affected by 2023 Wisconsin Act (Senate Bill 668), is amended to read:

220.02 (3) It is the intent of sub. (2) to give the division jurisdiction to enforce and carry out all laws relating to banks or banking in this state, including those relating to state banks, savings banks, savings and loan associations, and trust company banks, and also all laws relating to small loan companies or other loan companies or agencies, finance companies, insurance premium finance companies, earned wage access services providers, motor vehicle dealers, adjustment service companies, community currency exchanges, mortgage bankers, mortgage loan originators, mortgage brokers, and collection agencies and those relating to money transmitters under ch. 217, whether doing business as corporations, individuals, or otherwise, but to exclude laws relating to credit unions.”.

8. Page 20, line 15: after that line insert:

“(1s) RECONCILIATION PROVISIONS.

(a) If 2023 Senate Bill 668 is enacted into law, then the treatment of ss. 73.0301 (1) (d) 6. (by SECTION 1s), 108.227 (1) (e) 6. (by SECTION 2s), and 220.02 (3) (by SECTION 7s) and the renumbering of s. 138.09 (1a) (c) take effect on the effective date of 2023 Senate Bill 668 or on the effective date of this paragraph, whichever is later.

(b) If par. (a) does not apply, then the treatment of ss. 73.0301 (1) (d) 6. (by SECTION 1s), 108.227 (1) (e) 6. (by SECTION 2s), and 220.02 (3) (by SECTION 7s) and the renumbering of s. 138.09 (1a) (c) are void.”.
