### **CLEARINGHOUSE RULE 06-116**

#### **Comments**

[NOTE: All citations to "Manual" in the comments below are to the Administrative Rules Procedures Manual, prepared by the Revisor of Statutes Bureau and the Legislative Council Staff, dated January 2005.]

## 2. Form, Style and Placement in Administrative Code

- a. In the analysis, the comparison with rules in adjacent states does not provide a comparison. It just provides the citation to applicable rules.
  - b. In s. Opt 5.12 (intro.), "do any of the following" should be inserted before the colon.
- c. In s. Opt 7.03, "December 15 of each odd-numbered year" should be replaced with "January 1 of each even-numbered year" to be consistent with the current section. If the date is being changed, striking and underscoring should be used.
- d. Section Opt 8.03 (4) should be rewritten in the active voice "(4) The board may approve alternate...."

## 3. Conflict With or Duplication of Existing Rules

Section RL 10.02 (1) (a) refers to s. Opt 6.04, which is being repealed and recreated by this rule-making order. The department should review whether the reference is still correct.

#### 5. Clarity, Grammar, Punctuation and Use of Plain Language

- a. In s. Opt 5.12 (2), "exceeds" should be replaced with "exceed" and a comma should be inserted after "training."
- b. In s. Opt 7.05 (2) (intro.), the comma after "Stats." should be stricken and a semi-colon should be inserted.

- c. In Opt 8.01 (1), a hyphen should be inserted between "2" and "year."
- d. In Opt 8.02 (7), "shall" should be replaced with "may."
- e. In Opt 8.02 (8), it appears that "second year of the" should be inserted before "biennium."
- f. In s. Opt 8.03 (2) (intro.), it may be better to state that a course must meet all of the following criteria to be approved as a continuing education course.
- g. In the note after s. Opt 8.03 (5), there is a typographical error in the first telephone number. A hyphen should replace the comma.
