### CLEARINGHOUSE RULE 08-103

#### Comments

**[NOTE: All citations to “Manual” in the comments below are to the Administrative Rules Procedures Manual, prepared by the Legislative Reference Bureau and the Legislative Council Staff, dated September 2008.]**

#### **2. Form, Style and Placement in Administrative Code**

a. In the plain language analysis section of the rule analysis: (a) “environmental protection agency” should be inserted after “U.S.” and parentheses should be added around “EPA”; (b) the first occurrence of “CAIR” should be spelled out; and (c) in the third bullet point, the word “of” should be replaced by the word “or.”

b. In s. NR 428.07 (1) (b) 1., the second cross-reference should read: “s. ~~NR~~ ss. NR 428.08 and 439.09.”

#### **5. Clarity, Grammar, Punctuation and Use of Plain Language**

In the summary of factual data section of the rule analysis, a period should be added at the end of the first sentence.
