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### CLEARINGHOUSE RULE 11-017

#### Comments

#### **2. Form, Style and Placement in Administrative Code**

a. Under the heading “Proposed Order”, the introductory clause should be in the following format: “The Hearing and Speech Examining Board proposes an order to repeal HAS 8.03 (1) (Note) and to amend HAS 8.03 (1), (3), and (6) and 8.04 (6)”. [See s. 1.02 (1), Manual.]

b. In SECTION 4, the format for amending words to capitalize them is incorrect. Generally, to amend a single word, the existing word is stricken-through in its entirety and the new word is inserted and underscored immediately after the strike-through. [s. 1.06 (2), Manual.] Here, to capitalize certain words in a string, the amending may be accomplished as follows: “~~American academy of audiology, American speech language hearing association, Wisconsin department of public instruction, international hearing society or the national board for certification in hearing instrument sciences~~ American Academy of Audiology, American Speech-Language-Hearing Association, Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction, International Hearing Society or the National Board for Certification in Hearing Instrument Sciences.” [Note that in the rule, the word “certification” is misspelled].

#### **5. Clarity, Grammar, Punctuation and Use of Plain Language**

a. In SECTION 2, the board repeals the note following s. HAS 8.03 (1). The analysis should explain why the note is being repealed. Is the list of programs and courses referenced in the note no longer available?

b. In s. HAS 8.03 (6), in the third sentence, "A licensee will be required" should read "The licensee is required".
