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CLEARINGHOUSE RULE 14-025

Comments

2. Form, Style and Placement in Administrative Code

a. In SECTIONS 1, 5, 19, and 21, the order of stricken and underscored text should be revised to conform to the style prescribed by s. 1.06, Manual.

b. Throughout the proposed rule, when the agency renumbers and amends a rule provision, it is unnecessary to indicate the renumbering of the provision using stricken and underscored text. [See s. 1.067 (Example 2), Manual.]

c. In s. NR 27.03 (1) (Note), “US” should be changed to “U.S.” and all of the other words that are capitalized should be changed to the lowercase. [See s. 1.01 (4), Manual.]

5. Clarity, Grammar, Punctuation and Use of Plain Language

a. In the analysis of the proposed rule, the sentence at the bottom of page 3 should be revised for clarity.

b. In SECTION 33, the agency should clarify the intended effective date of the proposed rule.
