## **CLEARINGHOUSE RULE 14-025**

#### **Comments**

[NOTE: All citations to "Manual" in the comments below are to the Administrative Rules Procedures Manual, prepared by the Legislative Reference Bureau and the Legislative Council Staff, dated November 2011.]

## 2. Form, Style and Placement in Administrative Code

- a. In SECTIONS 1, 5, 19, and 21, the order of stricken and underscored text should be revised to conform to the style prescribed by s. 1.06, Manual.
- b. Throughout the proposed rule, when the agency renumbers and amends a rule provision, it is unnecessary to indicate the renumbering of the provision using stricken and underscored text. [See s. 1.067 (Example 2), Manual.]
- c. In s. NR 27.03 (1) (Note), "US" should be changed to "U.S." and all of the other words that are capitalized should be changed to the lowercase. [See s. 1.01 (4), Manual.]

## 5. Clarity, Grammar, Punctuation and Use of Plain Language

- a. In the analysis of the proposed rule, the sentence at the bottom of page 3 should be revised for clarity.
- b. In SECTION 33, the agency should clarify the intended effective date of the proposed rule.
