Comments

5. Clarity, Grammar, Punctuation and Use of Plain Language

a. In the introductory clause of the proposed rule, it is not necessary to capitalize the phrase “Leaf Tobacco Buying and Selling”. [s. 1.01 (4), Manual.]

b. In the rule summary’s listing of the place to submit comments, a specific deadline should be given for submitting comments.

c. In SECTION 2 of the proposed rule, the word “third” should be deleted, if the effective date is intended to be the standard given under s. 227.22 (2) (intro.), Stats., for the month following publication in the Wisconsin Administrative Register. Did the department intend to delay the effective date beyond the default date specified by s. 227.22 (2) (intro.), Stats.? Also, the title for “administrative register” should be capitalized. [s. 1.02 (4) (a) (Example), Manual.]
