#### Comments

#### 5. Clarity, Grammar, Punctuation and Use of Plain Language

- a. In s. NR 400.02 (162) (a) 58., the first “t” should be capitalized in “trans-chloro-3,3,3-trifluoroprop-1-ene (Solstice TM 1233zd(E))”, and there should be an additional parentheses after the last parentheses.
- b. In 40 CFR 51.100 (s), “trans-chloro-3,3,3-trifluoroprop-1-ene” is written as “trans 1-chloro-3,3,3-trifluoroprop-1-ene”. Consider whether it needs to be changed to match federal code.
- c. In s. NR 404.05 (2) (intro.), PM<sub>2.5</sub> precedes PM<sub>10</sub>; however, in the following sections PM<sub>10</sub> (listed in s. NR 404.05 (2) (a)) precedes PM<sub>2.5</sub> (listed in s. NR 404.05(2) (am)).
- d. In s. NR 404.05 (3) (intro.), PM<sub>2.5</sub> precedes PM<sub>10</sub>; however, in the following sections PM<sub>10</sub> (listed in s. NR 404.05 (3) (a)) precedes PM<sub>2.5</sub> (listed in s. NR 404.05 (3) (am)).
- e. In s. NR 404.05 (4) (intro.), PM<sub>2.5</sub> precedes PM<sub>10</sub>; however, in the following sections PM<sub>10</sub> (listed in s. NR 404.05 (4) (a)) precedes PM<sub>2.5</sub> (listed in s. NR 404.05 (4) (am)).
- f. In s. NR 405.02 (3), it appears that the word “to” is missing after the word “equal” on the sixth line.
- g. In s. NR 405.02 (21m) (intro.), the words “all of the following” are unnecessary, and the clause should end in a colon.
- h. In s. NR 405.02 (22m) (a) (intro.), the words “any of the following” are unnecessary.

i. In s. NR 405.07 (8) (a) 3m., should the “24 hour average” be retained even though the measure is now zero micrograms per cubic meter?

j. The changes in SECTION 24 should be accomplished by amending those sections to remove the hyphens.
