#### Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Based upon data collected by the Division of Emergency Management from local units of government affected by major disasters from January 1, 2005 to the present, it is assumed that approximately \$3 million in damages and costs may be eligible for payment under the major disaster assistance fund. Review of applications submitted to the administrator under this rule will be performed by staff from the Department of Military Affairs and Wisconsin Emergency Management. There are no provisions in the law to cover the costs incurred by WEM in administering this grant program. It is anticipated that the increased workload will be significant, but the agency will have to make do with current staff. Additional costs for supplies and services will Likewise have to be absorbed within the agency's existent budget.

### Long-Range Fiscal Implications
