The rules create a new certification, dw elling contractor qualifier, issued to an individual in order to fulfill the educational obligations established under 2005 Wisconsin Act 200. The fulfillment of education obligations will be necessary in order to obtain a building permit for w ork on dw ellings as directed by statutory direction under s. 101.65 (1m), Stats.

The rules implement the statutory directives of 2005 Wisconsin Act 200.

The proposed rules implement the mandates imposed by 2005 Wisconsin Act 200. The Act establishes educational obligations for contractors who need to obtain building permits involving work on one- and two- family dw ellings. The department does not believe that the proposed rules will increase the effect on small businesses over that imposed by the Act.

1.
