<u>Clearinghouse comment 5. a.</u> In the first sentence of s. Comm 48.100 (8) (a), "which" is not changed to "that" because as stated in par. 1062b of *The Gregg Reference Manual, Seventh Edition*, "which is preferred to that . . . when that has already been used in the sentence." This preference is likewise applied in the subsequent paragraph.

5. c. In s. Comm 48.300 (2) (a) 2., both occurrences of "which" are not changed to "that" because as stated in par. 1062b of *The Gregg Reference Manual, Seventh Edition*, "which is preferred to *that*... when there are two or more parallel essential clauses in the same sentence."
