Rule Summary:

The Bureau of Air Management proposes to increase the fees for reviewing applications to construct or modify sources of air pollution and to change its present policy of not collecting fees for significant review work performed when an application is withdrawn. These proposed changes are necessary to ensure that the new source review program has adequate funding to perform it's duties in accordance with requirements and deadlines mandated under s. 285.61, Wis. Stats. The Board last authorized a fee increase in 1999.

Fiscal Summary:

Revenue increase of \$1,334,307 is projected based on a four year actual average for revenue generated through new source review fees for FY2006-2009 of \$1,647,293.

This proposal does not seek to authorize an increase to Chapter 20 spending authority.
