ORDER REPEALING RULE

The proposal to repeal section PSC 52.07 was published in the August Notice Section of the Wisconsin Administrative Register. The Commission has received no petition for public hearing as provided for in section 227.02(1)(e), Wisconsin Statutes.

Now, therefore, pursuant to authority vested in the Public Service Commission of Wisconsin by Chapter 194, Wisconsin Statutes, the Public Service Commission hereby orders:

1. That section PSC 52.07, Wisconsin Administrative Code, be and the same hereby is repealed.
2. That, as provided for in section 227.026, Wisconsin Statutes, section PSC 52.07 cease to be effective as of November 1, 1957.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that certified copies of this order repealing section PSC 52.07, Wisconsin Administrative Code, be filed with the Secretary of State and the Revisor of Statutes, as required by section 227.023, Wisconsin Statutes.
