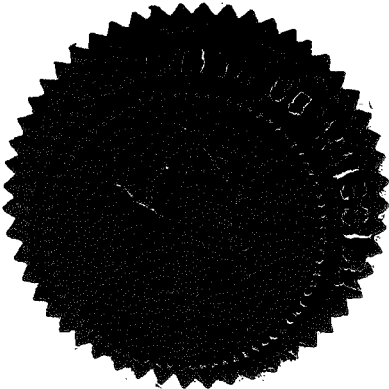

ORDER OF THE STATE CONSERVATION COMMISSION OF WISCONSIN
ADOPTING, AMENDING OR REPEALING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the State Conservation Commission of Wisconsin by sections 29.085, 29.174 and 23.09, Wis. Stats., the State Conservation Commission of Wisconsin hereby adopts rules as follows:

Section WCD 20.05 (4) (a) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is repealed and recreated to read:

WCD 20.05 (4) (a) The open season for taking, killing or capturing frogs shall be from April 30 to December 31, both dates inclusive.

The rules contained herein shall take effect on April 1, 1959.
