ORDER OF THE INDUSTRIAL COMMISSION
ADOPTING, AMENDING OR REPEALING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the Industrial Commission by sections 101.01 - 101.29 Wisconsin Stats., the Industrial Commission hereby adopts rule as follows:

Section Ind 41.51 (5) (a) 1 of Chapter Ind 41 relative to Boilers and Unfired Pressure Vessels of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is adopted to read:

"Pressure vessels used for water conditioning and filtration are exempt from relief valve requirements when connected to municipal water mains and when there is no check valve between such vessels and the water main."

The rule contained herein shall take effect on August 1, 1959 as provided in section 227.
