ORDER ADOPTING REVISED HULE

Notice of Proposed amendment of section PSC 185.20 (2)(b) was published in the June 1959 Notice Section of the Wisconsin Administrative Register. The Commission has received no petition for public hearing as provided for in section 227.02(1)(e), Statutes.

ORDER

HOW, THEREFORE, Pursuant to authority vested in the Public Service Commission by Chapter 196, Wis. Stats., the Commission orders that said section PSC 185.20(2)(b) be and the same hereby is amended to read as it appears in the following form to be filed with the Secretary of State and the Revisor of Statutes, as required by sections 227.023 and 227.024, Wis. Stats:

ORDER OF THE FUELIC SERVICE COMMISSION AMENDING A RULE

Pursuant to authority vested in the Public Service Commission by Chapter 196, Wis. Stats., the Commission hereby amends a rule as follows:

Section PSC 185.20(2)(b) of the WISCONSIN ADMINIS-TRATIVE CODE is smended to read:

> PSC 185.20(2)(b) If the utility rolds the meters at the end of each billing period, the utility may leave the meter reading forms when access to meters cannot be gained. If requested by the customer, the utility shall provide such forms. If no form is left or the form is not returned in time for the billing operation, a minimum or estimated bill may be rendered. In cases of emergency, the utility may render minimum or estimated (average) bills without reading meters or supplying meter reading forms to customers. Only in unusual cases or when approval is obtained from the customer shall more than three consecutive estimated bills be rendered where bills are rendered monthly and there shall be not more than two consecutive estimated bills where the billing period is two months or more.

The amendment contained herein shall take effect on September 1, 1959, as provided in section 227,026, Wis. State.
