ORDER OF THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE  
RENUMBERING AND ADOPTING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the State Department of Agriculture by section 97.43, Wis. Stats., the State Department of Agriculture hereby rennumbers and adopts rules as follows:

SECTION 1. Section Ag 85.06 (4) of the Wisconsin administrative code is rennumbered Ag 85.06 (5).

SECTION 2. Section Ag 85.06 (4) of the Wisconsin administrative code is adopted to read:

Ag 85.06 (4) Coding of consumer packages. Persons packaging butter shall mark or code each consumer package or bulk container of consumer packages of butter and shall keep records from which the department can determine the name of the grader certifying the grade and the date of printing or churning.

The rules contained herein shall take effect on July 1, 1960.
