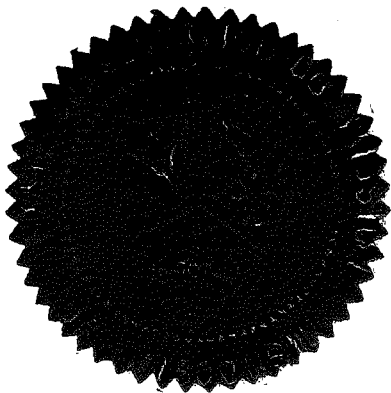

ORDER OF THE STATE CONSERVATION COMMISSION OF WISCONSIN, ADOPTING RULES

Pursuant to the authority vested in the State Conservation Commission of Wisconsin by section 29.174, Wis. State., and pursuant to the public policy expressed in Chapter 9, Laws of 1961, the said State Conservation Commission hereby adopts rules as follows:

Section WCD 20.03 (1), (a), (b), (c), (d), (e), (f), (g) and (3) (introductory paragraph) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code are amended to read:

No person shall have in his possession or under his control any spear or similar device in any building, tent, shanty or similar enclosure on the waters of Lake Butte des Morts and Winneconne in Winnebago county; Lake Poygan in Waushara and Winnebago counties, Lake Winnebago in Calumet, Fond du Lac, and Winnebago counties, Little Lake Butte des Morts in Outagamie and Winnebago counties, and all connecting waters including the Wolf river from the dam at Shawano downstream to Lake Poygan and the Fox river from Milepost No. 63, commonly known as Johnson creek in Green Lake county downstream to Lake Butte des Morts, except during the open season for spearing sturgeon when such open season is in effect on a specified water named above.

All speared sturgeon shall be tagged pursuant to section 29.148, Wis. Stats.

(3) A closed season is established for the taking, catching, or killing of fish of any variety or fishing for fish from December 1 to the following April 28, both dates inclusive, on all waters commonly known as the Chippewa flowage and that part of the Chippewa river in the following described area, Sawyer county:

Section WCD 20.04 (h) (b) 1. of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended to read:

WCD 20.04 (h) (b) 1. Fishing in such waters is authorized from April 29 to September 7 under permit only which may be secured at the checking stations indicated by posted signs in the immediate area.

This order shall be effective upon publication.
