ORDER AMENDING RULES

Notice of proposed amendment of sections PSC  
72.02(2) and PSC 72.03(1) was published in the June 1961  
Notice Section of the Wisconsin Administrative Register.  
The Commission has received no petition for public hearing  
as provided for in section 227.02(1)(e), Statutes.

ORDER

Pursuant to authority vested in the Public Serv-  
ice Commission by Chapter 195, Wis. Stats., the Commission  
orders that sections PSC 72.02(2) and PSC 72.03(1), Wiscon-  
sin Administrative Code, be and the same hereby are amended  
to read as follows:

PSC 72.02(2) Any nonfatal accident other  
than at a grade crossing which causes disability  
to a railroad employe of more than 24 hours in

the aggregate during the 10 days (240 hours) immediately following the accident or disability to a nonemployee of more than 1 day or any such accident involving a rail movement causing in excess of \$750 damage to any nonrailroad building or other land improvement shall be reported to the Commission by such means of communication as will insure delivery within 10 days.

PSC 72.03(1) Monthly reports of all accidents shall be made to the Commission. In making these reports, each railroad company shall be governed by the interstate commerce commission rules relating to monthly reports of railway accidents, effective February 1, 1961, except as hereinafter modified or amplified.

The rules as herein amended shall take effect on September 1, 1961, as provided in section 227.026(1), Wis. Stats.
