ORDER OF THE BOARD OF VETERANS AFFAIRS ADOPTING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the Board of Veterans Affairs, by Section 45.35(4), Visconsin Statutes, Section VA 5.05 (30) of the present Veterans Affairs Code is amended to read as follows:

VA 5.05 (30) The department may make a loan to a veteran who has previously owned a home and sold it. Such veteran must submit a valld reason for the sale of such home and must show that his equity from the sale is used to acquire his new dwelling. A sale of a home which has occurred more than one year prior to the date of loan application will not be subject to the provisions of this section. The department may allow the veteran to pay obligations from his equity If It is determined that such obligations were incurred for medical, hospital or funeral expenses for which the veteran is legally responsible and which would hamper his ability to make his future mortgage payments.

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This is to certify that the foregoing is a true and correct copy of the Code Amendment duly and legally adopted by the Board of Veterans Affairs at a legal meeting held on the 21st day of July, 1961.
