### ORDER ADOPTING RULES

Motice of proposed rules in section PSC 95.01 (6) and (7), Wisconsin Administrative Code, was published in the March 1964 Notice Section of the Administrative Register. The Commission has received no petition for public hearing as provided for in section 227.02 (1)(e), Statutes.

#### Order

# THE COMMISSION THEMESORE ORDERS:

- 1. That pursuant to authority vested in the Public Service Commission by chapter 22, Wis. Stats., the Commission hereby adopts section PSC 95.01 (6) and (7), Wiscomsin Administrative Code, to read:
  - PSC 95.01 (6) USS OF PRIVATE CARRIER VEHICLES. During the existence of a state of emergency, as defined in section PSC 95.01 (introductory paragraph), authorized for-hire carriers may lease vehicles with drivers from private motor carriers on a trip basis to perform operations in accordance with the provisions of this chapter. Such leases
  - (a) Shall be in writing and signed by the parties thereto, or their regular employes or agents, and shall show the identification number of the vehicles.
  - (b) Shall provide for the exclusive possession, control, and use of the motor vehicle involved, by the authorized carrier and the complete

assumption by such authorized carrier of full responsibility to the public, the shippers, the public service commission, and the motor vehicle department of Wisconsin during the entire period of the lease.

- (c) Shall specify the time the lease begins and the circumstances on which it ends, and the amount of compensation or basis thereof, for the use of the motor vehicle involved.
- PSC 95.01 (7) AUTHORIZATION FOR PRIVATE MOTOR CARRIERS OF PROPERTY. The I.C.C.-Wisconsin Emergency Transport Board and its staff may authorize private motor carriers of property to perform operations for-hire as contract motor carriers during an emergency as defined in section PSC 95.01 (introductory paragraph), provided that
- (a) It is necessary to utilize the equipment and personnel of private motor carriers to fulfill the functions of emergency transportation service under the provisions of the Wisconsin operational survival plan and the Federal plan for civil defense.
- (b) It is impractical to arrange for a lease arrangement under the provisions of subsection PSC 95.01 (6).
- (c) Such authorization shall be for a specific trip, movement of specific shipments, or other specifically designated short-term operation not to exceed a 30-day period.
- (d) The I.C.C.-Wisconsin Emergency Transport Board and its staff may revoke or suspend the above authorization prior to the expiration thereof.
- 2. That certified copies of the above-adopted rules be filed with the Secretary of State and Revisor of Statutes, as required by section 227.023, Wis. Stats.
