

ORDER OF THE WISCONSIN STATE BOARD OF ACCOUNTANCY

Pursuant to authority vested in the Wisconsin State Board of Accountancy by section 135.01 Wis. Stats., the Wisconsin State Board of Accountancy hereby adopts and amends the following rules:

Page 2 - Order of the Wisconsin State Board of Accountancy

Accy 3.04 (3) is amended to read:

(3) A candidate who fails in the remaining three trials to receive passing grades in the remaining subjects, shall revert to the status of a new applicant, and will be required to write all subjects in the event he again is a candidate, provided however, that if the candidate shall have but one subject remaining after his fourth trial, and shall have received a grade of 60 or better in that subject on his last examination, he may have one more trial to pass that remaining subject before he reverts to the status of a new applicant.


Accy 3.05 is created to read:

Accy 3.05 Examination grades of other states. A candidate for the C. P. A. certificate who becomes domiciled in this state, and who has acquired examination passing credits under the uniform examination of another state, may apply for acceptance of those credits by this state, toward his fulfillment of the requirements for his C. P. A. certificate in this state. The board will, in its discretion, accept such credits, provided the candidate could have otherwise qualified as a candidate in this state.

The rule and amendment contained herein shall take effect as provided in section 227.026 (1) Wis. Stats.
