

STATE OF WISCONSIN
Public Employes Social Security Fund

Pursuant to authority vested in the Public Employes Social Security Fund by section 66.99 (11), Wis. Stats., the Director promulgates the following rule:

SSF 1.053 FEES

A fee. comprises payment for personal services not customarily compensated by wages or salaries, and shall be limited to either:

- a. Payment for a specific act of a public official performed in his official capacity, including fees of officials fixed by statute, or
- b. Payment to members of a profession licensed, registered or certified by the state to perform or furnish a specific professional service for which by custom or otherwise the compensation is a fixed amount. Compensation for any continuing relationship, express or implied, shall not be deemed a fee but shall be considered as salary regardless of the method of determining the compensation.
