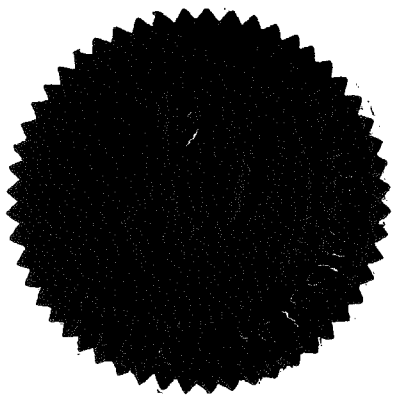

ORDER OF THE STATE CONSERVATION COMMISSION OF WISCONSIN

ADOPTING, AMENDING AND REPEALING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the Conservation Director of the State Conservation Commission of Wisconsin by sections 227.027, 23.09 and 29.085, Wis. Stats., the State Conservation Commission of Wisconsin hereby amends rules as follows:

Section WCD 10.01 (4) (c) (1) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended to read:

WCD 10.01 (4)

Kind of Animal and Locality	Open Season (both dates inclusive)	Bag Limit
(c) Beaver ZONE A	Feb. 5 thru April 17	35 per season
(1) All that part of the state lying northerly of a line beginning at the junction of State Highway 64 and the west boundary of the state, thence easterly along said Highway 64 to its junction with State Highway 32, thence northerly along said Highway 32 to its junction with U. S. Highway 8, thence easterly along said Highway 8 to its junction with the Menominee River which is the boundary of the state.		

The amendment contained herein shall take effect on April 17, 1966 following publication in the official state paper as provided in section 227.027, Wis. Stats., as an emergency rule. Facts constituting the emergency are as follows:

The harvest of beaver in the area in Northern Wisconsin included under Zone A has been excessive, and to protect the breeding population of this species in said area, it is in the interest of the public welfare that the season in such area should be closed.

The preservation of the public safety and welfare necessitates the adoption of such rule as an emergency rule.
