ORDER OF THE BOARD OF VETERANS AFFAIRS ADOPTING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the Board of Veterans Affairs of the Wisconsin Department of Veterans Affairs, by Section 45.35(4), Wis. Stats., The Board of Veterans Affairs amends Section VA 2.02(2) of the present Wisconsin Administrative Code to read as follows:

VA 2.02(2) TIME FOR APPLYING, REIMBURSEMENT.
To be approved, an application must be made to the department prior to satisfactory completion of the course or courses for which application for reimbursement is made. The veteran will be reimbursed for the cost of textbooks and fees to the extent authorized, upon the receipt of notice of satisfactory completion from the school.

This amendment shall take effect on May 1, 1966, as provided in section 227.26(1).
