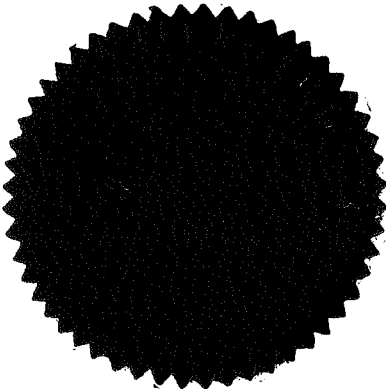

ORDER OF THE STATE CONSERVATION COMMISSION OF WISCONSIN

ADOPTING, AMENDING, REPEALING AND CREATING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the State Conservation Commission of Wisconsin, by sections 23.09, 23.11, 27.01 and 28.02, Wis. Stats., the State Conservation Commission of Wisconsin hereby adopts, amends, repeals and creates rules as follows:

Section 1. WCD 45.01 (3) (j) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is repealed and recreated to read:

WCD 45.01 (3) (j) A parent or parents with their children and not more than two lineal relatives.

Section 2. WCD 45.08 (2) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended to read:

WCD 45.08 (2) It shall be unlawful to operate or park any motor vehicle upon any bridle path, hiking trail, beach area, playground, picnic area, golf course (except golf carts on golf courses) or any area other than established roads, parking areas, boat ramps and service areas, or contrary to posted notice.

Section 3. WCD 45.08 (5) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is created to read:

WCD 45.08 (5) It shall be unlawful to operate any motor-driven sled, toboggan or other snowmobile on any hiking trail, bridle path or other area in any state park, the Kettle Moraine State Forest and Point Beach State Forest except where their use is specifically authorized by posted notice.

Section 4. WCD 45.09 (1) (o) and (4) (g) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code are created to read:

WCD 45.09 (1) (o) Butler lake in the Kettle Moraine State Forest, section 20, T14N, R20E, town of Mitchell, Sheboygan county, Wisconsin.

(4) (g) Lowe creek pond, sections 29 and 30, T22N, R5W, town of Nixon, Jackson county, Wisconsin.

Section 5. WCD 45.13 (2) (b) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended to read:

WCD 45.13 (2) (b) Camping on the Apostle Island State Forest and at designated campsites on other state-owned islands.

Section 6. WCD 45.13 (2) (c) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is repealed.

Section 7. WCD 45.13 (3) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is repealed and recreated to read:

WCD 45.13 (3) (a) Payment of camping fees is waived on the American Legion, Black River, Brule River, Flambeau River and Northern Highland State Forests between October 31 and the following April 1.

(b) Payment of camping fees is waived on the Apostle Island State Forest, the Elroy-Sparta State Trail, and at trail campsites in the Kettle Moraine State Forest.

Section 8. WCD 45.13 (9) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended to read:

WCD 45.13 (9) No camping party shall start setting up or taking down its camping unit between the hours of 10 p.m. and the following 6 a.m.

Section 9. WCD 45.16 (1) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended to read:

WCD 45.16 (1) It shall be unlawful for any person to use any facility, land or area for which a fee or charge has been established by the commission without payment of such fee or charge as listed in the following schedule:

Camping (tent or trailer)	\$2.00 per day per family or individual group

- (d) First Capitol
- (e) Lizard Mound
- (f) Lost Dauphin
- (g) New Glarus Woods
- (h) Ojibwa
- (i) Old Wade House

Section 11. WCD 45.19 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is renumbered WCD 45.20.

Section 12. WCD 45.19 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is created to read:

WCD 45.19 Beaches. (1) It shall be unlawful for any person to carry or consume any food or beverages of any kind on any bathing beach or in the water adjacent to any bathing beach in any state park, state park recreation area, the Kettle Moraine State Forest and Point Beach State Forest, except in designated areas.

(2) It shall be unlawful to swim beyond or disturb or molest a bathing beach boundary buoy or marker in any swimming beach in any state park, state park recreation area, and the Kettle Moraine and Point Beach Forests.

The rules contained herein shall take effect on June 1, 1966.

The rules contained herein were approved by the State Conservation Commission of Wisconsin at its meeting of April 15, 1966.
