

Pursuant to authority vested in the Industrial Commission of Wisconsin by Section 101.01 - 101.29 Wisconsin Statutes, and pursuant to Chapter 227, the Industrial Commission on March 8, 1966 voted to repeal and recreate section Ind 69.30 Shop Inspections as follows:

Ind 69.30 Shop Inspections

- (1) Inspection of boilers, pressure vessels, elevators, dumbwaiters, moving ramps, personnel hoists and similar devices, and parts of such devices, may be provided at reasonable times at the place of manufacture on request, but only when deemed by the commission to be essential and necessary.
- (2) Fees to be assessed and collected for shop inspections shall be as follows:
 - (a) One inspector's services - - - - \$85.00 per 8-hour day
 1. For services requiring less than 8 hours in any one day, the fee shall be \$12.00 per hour.
 2. Additional charges shall be assessed and collected for necessary expenses incurred by the inspector for travel, including mileage, meals and lodging. Travel expenses shall be limited to those allowable under commission employee travel regulations.
