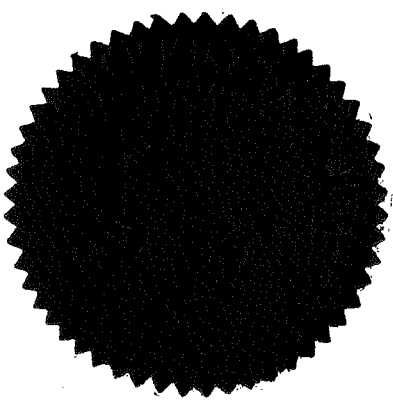

ORDER OF THE STATE CONSERVATION COMMISSION OF WISCONSIN
ADOPTING AND AMENDING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the Conservation Director of the
State Conservation Commission of Wisconsin by sections 29.174 (4a), 23.09,
and 227.027, Wis. Stats., the State Conservation Commission of Wisconsin
hereby amends rules as follows:

Section WCD 10.26 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is created to read:

WCD 10.26 Preservation of Wolf River scenic values, Menominee County.

(a) There shall be no open season and it shall be unlawful for any person to hunt or pursue any species of game at any time on the Wolf River and within 200' from the shoreline thereof in Menominee County from the northern county boundary downstream through Keshena Falls.

Section WCD 11.04 (5) (b) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended to read:

WCD 11.04 (5) (b) Boulder Junction.

Township 42 North, Range 6 East, Town of Boulder Junction.

Section 1 - All that part of the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 lying east and north of the Rearing Pond Road and all that part of the SE 1/4 lying east and north of a line formed by the Big Crooked Outlet Lake Road and the Picnic Point Road.

Township 42 North, Range 7 East, Town of Boulder Junction.

Section 5 - All that part lying west of the line formed by the Airport Road and the Mel Major Road.

Section 6 - Entire section except that part of the NW 1/4 lying east and north of Wolf Lake Creek and except that part of the NW 1/4 lying west of the Big Crooked Lake Portage Trail.

Section 8 - All that part lying west and south of the Airport Road except that part of the W 1/2 lying west of a line formed by the Boulder Lake Big Crooked Lake Portage Trail and the east shore of Boulder Lake.

Section 16 - All that part of the NW 1/4 lying north and west of Highway "M" and all that part lying south of the Manitowish River and north of Little Rice Lake.

Section 17 - All of section 17 except that part lying east and north of the Manitowish River and south of Highway "M".

Section 18 - All that part of the E 1/2 lying south of Boulder Lake.

Section 19 - All that part of the NE 1/4 lying east of the Cemetery Road and north of the east-west firelane.

Section 20 - The NE 1/4, the NE 1/4 of the NW 1/4, NW 1/4 lying north of the east-west firelane, and the E 1/2 of the SE 1/4.

Section 21 - The W 1/2 of the NW 1/4 except that part lying north of the Town Road (old County Highway "K") and east of a woods road running in a north-easterly-southwesterly direction, and the E 1/2 of the SW 1/4 except that part lying east of the Old Woods Road running in a northwesterly-south-easterly direction through said description.

Township 43 North, Range 7 East.

Section 31 - All that part of the E 1/2 lying south of Wolf Lake.

Section 32 - All that part of the SW 1/4 lying south and west of the Mel Major Road.

The amendment contained herein shall take effect the day of publication in the official state paper as provided in section 227.027, Wis. Stats., as an emergency rule. Facts constituting the emergency are as follows:

Provisions of section 30.251, Wis. Stats., contained in chapter 623, Laws of 1965, are effective beginning one week after the acceptance of the offer by the county as specified in said section. Acceptance of the offer was received August 26, 1966, and because this date is too close to the open hunting season dates prescribed for Menominee County, this rule is being processed as an emergency rule.

Also included is a revision in the present administrative code relating to the closed area in Vilas County.

The preservation of the public safety and welfare necessitates the adoption of such rules.


