
TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETINGS:

ORDER OF THE INDUSTRIAL COMMISSION

Pursuant to authority vested in the Industrial Commission by section 101.01 to 101.29 Wis. Stats., the Industrial Commission hereby creates and adopts rule as follows:

Section Ind 72.18 of the WISCONSIN ADMINISTRATIVE CODE is adopted to read:

Ind 72.18 Unwed Mothers in Domestic Service. The minimum wage of unwed mothers placed in domestic service by the State Department of Public Welfare or an agency licensed under the provisions of Section 48.66, Wis. Stats., shall not be less than \$20 per week plus room and board.

The rule contained herein shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin Administrative Code as provided in Section 227.
