

ORDER OF THE
WISCONSIN DEPARTMENT OF TAXATION
ADOPTING, AMENDING OR REPEALING
RULES

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Department of Taxation by Section 168.12(1) of the Wisconsin Statutes as amended in Section 173m of Chapter 43, Laws of 1967, the Department of Taxation amends Rule TAX 10.01 to read:

"Oil Inspection Fees. For the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1967 and for the 30 days next succeeding, the oil inspection fee shall be 1 3/4¢ for each 50 gallons of petroleum product from which the sample is taken."

This rule shall take effect as of July 1, 1967 as provided in Section 168.12(1).
