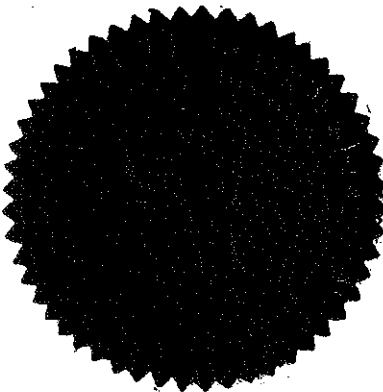

ORDER OF THE STATE CONSERVATION COMMISSION OF WISCONSIN

ADOPTING, AMENDING AND REPEALING RULES

PURSUANT to authority vested in the State Conservation Commission of Wisconsin, by sections 23.09, 23.11 and 27.01, Wis. Stats., the State Conservation Commission of Wisconsin hereby adopts rules as follows:

SECTION 1. WCD 41.12 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is created to read:

WCD 41.12 Cushing Memorial State Park. All state-owned lands now or that hereafter may come under the jurisdiction of the State Conservation Commission, located within the following areas, are established and designated as Cushing Memorial State Park:

Estimated Acreage

(1) T7N, R18E, Town of Delafield, Waushara county

Section 18 - That part of the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 located in the south 120 feet in the east 894 feet.

Section 19 - That part of the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 located north of the center line of the Bark river in the east 894 feet; also a right-of-way located south of the center line of the Bark river for a distance of 523.5 feet in the east 60 feet.

SECTION 2. WCD 41.13 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is created to read:

WCD 41.13 Lost Dauphin State Park. All state-owned lands now or that hereafter may come under the jurisdiction of the State Conservation Commission

located within the following areas, are established and designated as  
Lost Dauphin State Park:

Estimated Acreage

(1) T22N, R20E, Town of Lawrence, Brown county

That part of Lot 190, Williams Grant subdivision lying east of the public road to the channel of the Fox river and that part of Lot 130, Williams Grant subdivision described as follows: Commencing at the intersection of the south line of Lot 130 and the town road at a point, thence N 51 degrees 31' W, 1200 feet; thence N 33 degrees 30' E, 400 feet; thence S 51 degrees 30' E, 1076 feet to the intersection of the public road; thence southwesterly along the public road to the p.o.b.

SECTION 3. WCD 41.14 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is created to read:

WCD 41.14 Ojibwa State Roadside Park. All state-owned lands now or that hereafter may come under the jurisdiction of the State Conservation Commission, located within the following areas, are established and designated as Ojibwa State Roadside Park:

(1) T30N, R6W, Town of Ojibwa, Sawyer county

Section 2 - That part of Section 2 lying south of the Chippewa river and north of the railroad right-of-way.

Section 3 - That part of Section 3 lying south of the Chippewa river and north of the railroad right-of-way.
