ORDER OF THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE REPEALING, RENUMBERING AND REPEALING AND RECREATING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the Department of Agriculture by sections 93.07 (1) and (10) and chapter 95, Wis. Stats., the Department of Agriculture hereby repeals, renumbers and repeals and recreates rules as follows:

1. Section Ag 10.57 (1) (a) 2 of the Wisconsin administrative code is repealed and recreated to read:
