ORDER OF THE

PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION OF WISCONSIN

Pursuant to authority vested in the Public Service Commission by section 196.745, Wis. Stats., the Public Service Commission hereby amends a rule as follows:

Section PSC 135.10 (3) 841.231 of the WISCONSIN ADMINISTRATIVE CODE is amended to read:

PSC 135.10 (3) 841.231 (change) All smooth bends shall be free from buckling, cracks, or other evidence of mechanical damage. Smooth bends on pipe 4 inches in size and smaller shall have a difference between the maximum and minimum diameter of not more than 12.5 percent of the nominal diameter. All other smooth bends shall have a difference between the maximum and minimum diameter of not more than 2.5 percent. In addition, for smooth field bends on sizes 12 inches and larger, the longitudinal axis of the pipe shall not be deflected more than 1 degrees in any length along the pipe axis equal to the diameter of the pipe.

The amendment contained herein shall take effect on June 1, 1969 as provided in section 227.026 (1), Wis. Stats.
