## Order of the Visconsin Retirement Fund Board Adopting Rules

Pursuant to authority vested in the Wisconsin Retirement Fund Board by Section 41.04 (2) (e), Wis. Stats., the Board:

#### 1. Amends Ret 5.12 to read:

Ret 5.12 any application for a benefit may be withdrawn by the applicant at any time prior to approval of the application by the actuary and the director or the board. Any application withdrawn as provided herein shall have no force or effect, and any subsequent application shall be treated as a new application.

#### 2. Amends Ret 5.31 to read:

Ret 5.31 When an applicant for any benefit dies prior to approval of his application by the actuary and the director or the board, but the application is approved because information as to the death of the applicant has not been received, the approval of the application shall be automatically nullified.

### 3. Repeals and recreates Ret 8.02 (1) to read:

Ret 8.02 (1) Any participating employe who has filed a form 50 may, by notice to the fund on a prescribed form, provide that there be segregated for a variable annuity, as provided in s. 41.12 (4), an amount equal to 50% of the accumulated credits in all of his accounts (including an amount from the municipality accumulation account equal to the amount of employe normal contribution accumulations so segregated) at the beginning of the year in which the first form 50 executed by him was effective.
