ORDER OF THE

PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION

ADOPTING A RULE

Pursuant to authority vested in the Public Service Commission by chapter 194, Wis. Stats., the Commission hereby adopts a rule as follows:

Section PSC 53.02 of the WISCONSIN ADMINISTRATIVE CODE is created to read:

PSC 53.02 <u>Realigned, renumbered, or redesig-</u> <u>nated portions of route</u>. All common motor carriers are hereby required to advise the Commission when beginning operations over any portion of their certificated routes which has been realigned, renumbered, or redesignated.

The created rule contained herein shall take effect on August 1, 1970, pursuant to authority granted by section 227.026(1)(Intro. par.), Wis. Stats.
