AMENDING RULES

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Board of State Bar Commissioners by Section 256.281(5), Wis. Stats., and Rule Bar 1.02(7), Wisconsin Administrative Code, the Board of State Bar Commissioners hereby amends rules as follows:


Section Bar 2.02(2) of the WISCONSIN ADMINISTRATIVE CODE is repealed and recreated to read as follows:

(2) The written examination will consist of 5 sessions. The morning sessions will commence at 9:00 o'clock A.M. and afternoon sessions at 1:30 P.M. In administering such examination, the board may employ the multi-state bar examination prepared by the National Conference of Bar Examiners.

The amendment contained herein shall take effect on March 1, 1972.


