ORDER OF THE VETERINARY EXAMINING BOARD
AMENDING AND REPEALING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the Veterinary Examining Board by sec. 15.08 (5), Wis. Stats., and ch. 453, Wis. Stats., the Board hereby amends and repeals rules as follows:

Section VE 3.01 (3) of the Wis. Admin. Code is repealed.

Section VE 3.01 (4) is amended to read:

- (4) Direct supervision. A licensed veterinarian must order all work and assume full responsibility for all work performed by veterinary students. Further, the veterinarian must be available to give direct personal care to animal patients!


Section VE 3.02 (15) and (16) of the Wis. Admin. Code are repealed.

Section VE 3.04 of the Wis. Admin. Code is repealed.

The amendments and repeals contained herein shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin Administrative Register or as otherwise provided in sec. 227.026, Stats.
