ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES

BOARD CREATING RULES

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that pursuant to sections 350.09 and 350.11 Wisconsin Statutes and according to the procedure set forth in section 227.02(1)(e), Wisconsin Statutes, the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board hereby creates rules as follows:

NR 6.05(1)(b) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is created to read:

(b) The total vehicle noise produced by every snowmobile manufactured after July 1, 1972 and offered for sale or sold in Wisconsin, shall not exceed 82 dB on an A-weighted network at 50 feet when measured in accordance with the procedures described herein.


The foregoing rules were approved by State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on June 28, 1973.
