## ORDER OF THE CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES BOARD ADOPTING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the Controlled Substances

Board by Section 161.11(4), Wis. Stats., the Controlled Substances

Board hereby adopts the following rule:

Section CSB 2.07 of the WISCONSIN ADMINISTRATIVE CODE is adopted to read:

CSB 2.07 Transfer of Hydrochloride form of Etorphine from Schedule I to Schedule II. (1) Subsection (3) (intro. par.) of section 161.14, Wis. Stats., Schedule I is amended to read:

- (3) Unless specifically excepted or listed in another schedule, any of the following opium derivatives, their salts, isomers and salts of isomers whenever the existence of these salts, isomers, and salts of isomers is possible within the specific chemical designation:
- (2) Paragraph (em) of subsection (3), section 161.16, Wis. Stats., Schedule II, is hereby created to read:

(em) Etorphine Hydrochloride;

The rule contained herein shall take effect on September 1, 1974, pursuant to section 227.026(1), Wis. Stats.
