ORDER ADOPTING RULES

ORDER OF THE Department of Health and Social Services

ADOPTING, AMENDING AND REPEALING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the Department of Health and Social Services by sections 49.50, and 227.02(1)(e) Wis. Stats., the Department of Health and Social Services hereby amends and adopts rule PW-PA 20.22 as follows:


PW-PA 20.22 Liquid assets. (1) AID TO FAMILIES WITH DEPENDENT CHILDREN. Where a dependent child or children otherwise eligible for a grant of aid to families with dependent children together with relatives included in the grant of such aid have more than \$1500 in liquid assets, including cash or loan value of insurance, eligibility for a grant of aid to families with dependent children does not exist.

The amended rule contained herein shall take effect on February 1, 1975 as provided in section 227.02 (1)(e), Wis. Stats.
