

ORDER OF
DEPARTMENT OF INDUSTRY, LABOR AND HUMAN RELATIONS

Pursuant to authority vested in the Department of Industry, Labor and Human Relations by sections 101.01 to 101.20, Wis. Stats., the Department of Industry, Labor and Human Relations hereby amends, repeals and recreates, and adopts rules of Wisconsin Administrative Code, Chapter Ind 72 Minimum Wage.

The rules attached hereto shall become effective on July 1, 1975.

DEPARTMENT OF INDUSTRY, LABOR AND HUMAN RELATIONS
Wisconsin Minimum Wage Changes 1975, 1976 and 1977

Chapter Ind 72 Minimum wage is amended or repealed and recreated as follows:

Section 72.001(4) is amended to read as follows:

- (4) It shall be the policy of the department to review the National Consumer Price Index in January of each year. The Department may revise upward or downward by a ratio of one cent for each .4 point change in the preceding December index released using the December 1972 release as a base for the computations, but in no case shall the state minimum wage for adult employes fall below 90% of the federal minimum wage.

Section Ind 72.03(1) is amended to read as follows:

Ind 72.03 Minimum rates. (1) MINIMUM RATES. Except as provided for in sections Ind 72.06 through Ind 72.09, no employer shall employ an employe in any occupation, trade or industry, at a lesser hourly rate than is indicated below.

(a) Adult employes 18 years of age and over:	2.00 per hour	2.10 per hour	2.20 per hour

Section Ind 72.03(3) is amended to read as follows:

- (3) ALLOWANCE FOR BOARD AND LODGING. Where board and/or lodging are furnished by the employer in accordance with Section Ind 72.04, and accepted and received by the employe, an allowance may be made not to exceed the following amounts:

(a) Lodging--adults 18 years of age and over	16.00 per week or 2.30 per day	16.80 per week or 2.40 per day	17.60 per week or 2.50 per day
minors 17 years of age and under	12.80 per week or 1.85 per day	13.45 per week or 1.90 per day	14.10 per week or 2.00 per day
(b) Meals--adults 18 years of age and over	24.00 per week or 1.15 per meal	25.20 per week or 1.20 per meal	26.40 per week or 1.25 per meal
minors 17 years of age and under	19.20 per week or .90 per meal	20.15 per week or .95 per meal	21.10 per week or 1.00 per meal

Section Ind 72.05 is amended to read as follows:

Ind 72.05 Agriculture. (1) MINIMUM RATES. The minimum wage of employes employed in agriculture shall be as follows:

(a) Adult employes 18 years of age and over:	1.80 per hour	1.89 per hour	1.98 per hour
(b) Minors 17 years of age and under:	1.44 per hour	1.51 per hour	1.58 per hour

(2) ALLOWANCE FOR BOARD AND LODGING. Where board and/or lodging are furnished by the employer in accordance with Section Ind 72.04, and accepted and received by the employe, an allowance may be made not to exceed the following amounts:

(a) Lodging--adults 18 years of age and over	14.40 per week or 2.05 per day	15.10 per week or 2.15 per day	15.85 per week or 2.25 per day
minors 17 years of age and under	11.50 per week or 1.65 per day	12.10 per week or 1.75 per day	12.65 per week or 1.80 per day
(b) Meals----adults 18 years of age and over	21.60 per week or 1.05 per meal	22.70 per week or 1.10 per meal	23.75 per week or 1.15 per meal
minors 17 years of age and under	17.30 per week or .80 per meal	18.10 per week or .85 per meal	18.95 per week or .90 per meal

Section Ind 72.07(3) Seasonal Recreational or Educational Camps is amended as follows:

(3) Counselors. The minimum wage of counselors employed in seasonal recreational or educational camps and day camps may be computed on a weekly basis as follows:

(a) Adult counselors 18 years of age and over:			
1. If board and lodging are not furnished-----	90.00	94.50	99.00
2. If board only is furnished-----	66.00	69.30	72.60
3. If board and lodging are furnished-----	50.00	52.50	55.00
(b) Counselors 17 years of age and under:			
1. If board and lodging are not furnished-----	72.00	75.60	79.20
2. If board only is furnished-----	52.80	55.45	58.10
3. If board and lodging are furnished-----	40.00	42.00	44.00

Section Ind 72.08 Caddies is amended to read as follows:

Ind 72.08 Caddies. (1) The minimum wage of employes employed as caddies shall be:

2.50	9 holes	2.65	9 holes	2.75	9 holes
4.35	18 holes	4.60	18 holes	4.80	18 holes
