ORDER OF THE CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES
BOARD ADOPTING RULES

Notice of proposed rule CSB 2.08 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code was published in the April, 1975, Wisconsin Administrative Register; that the Controlled Substances Board has received no notice, request or petition for a public hearing and the period for filing such request or petition has expired.

Therefore, pursuant to authority vested in the Controlled Substances Board by Section 161.11, Wis. Stats., the Controlled Substances Board hereby adopts the following rule:

Section CSB 2.08 of the WISCONSIN ADMINISTRATIVE CODE is adopted to read:

CSB 2.08 Addition of Poppy Straw to Schedule II, addition of Pemoline and Mebutamate to Schedule IV. Paragraph (d) of subsec. (2), sec. 161.16, Wis. Stats., Schedule II is hereby created to read:


(d) Concentrate of Poppy Straw (the crude extract of Poppy Straw in either liquid, solid or powder form which contains the phenanthrene alkaloids of the opium poppy).

Paragraph (n) of subsec. (2) of sec. 161.20, Wis. Stats., Schedule IV is hereby created to read:

(n) Mebutamate

Paragraph (b) of subsec. (2m) of sec. 161.20, Wis. Stats., Schedule IV is hereby created to read:

(b) Pemoline.
