SECTION 1 - Section NR 5.21 is created to read:

ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD CREATING RULES

Pursuant to the authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board by sections 30.635 and 227.014, Wisconsin Statutes, the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board hereby creates rules as follows:

- NR 5.21 Lakes upon which the slow-no-wake speed restriction is modified or waived. The Wisconsin department of natural resources hereby defines by rule, pursuant to section 30.635, Wis. Stats., the following waters upon which the slowno-wake speed restriction is modified or waived:
- (1) The slow-no-wake speed restriction is waived on the waters of Dutchman (Lad) lake, located in section 2, township 6 north, range 17 east in Waukesha county.

The foregoing rules were approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on February 17, 1977.

The rules contained herein shall take effect upon publication.
