ORDER AFFECTING RULE

An order to amend section Eth 2.02 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code.

Pursuant to the authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Ethics Board by sections 19.43(1), 19.48(1)(a), Wisconsin Statutes, and by Chapter 227, Wisconsin Statutes, the Ethics Board modifies its rules as follows:

Analysis by Ethics Board

This rule is designed solely to bring the language of the existing rule into conformity with Wisconsin Statutes as affected by section 105 of Chapter 29 of the Laws of 1977. That section amended section 19.42(8), Wisconsin Statutes in this manner:

19.42(8) "State public official" means all persons appointed by the governor with the advice and consent of the senate, except-trustees of-any-private-higher-educational-institution-receiving-state-appropriations, and all persons identified under s. 20.923, except officers and employes of the judiciary, trustees and employes of the investment board, and teaching personnel of the university of Wisconsin system, non-professional legislative employes, and trustees of any private higher educational institution receiving state appropriations.

Section Eth 2.02 is amended to read:

Eth 2.02 Initial statement of economic interests. Each person appointed-to-a-position-identified who is a state public official solely by reason of his or her identification in section 20.923, Wis. Stats., other-than-the-positions-of-employe--of-the-investment board-or-teaching-personnel-of-the-university-of-Wisconsin-system or-a-position-within-the-judicial-branch-of-government shall file a statement of economic interests with the board within 21 days following the date of taking office unless he or she has filed a statement of economic interests with the board subsequent to the preceding March 1.

The explanatory material following section Eth 2.02 is unaffected by this amendment.

The rule contained herein shall take effect as provided in section 227.026(1), Wisconsin Statutes.
