RULES OF THE MEDICAL EXAMINING BOARD

CHAPTER MED 15

PRACTICE OF MEDICINE AND SURGERY DEFINED: EXCLUSION OF TATTOOING AND EAR PIERCING.

Med 15.01 Authority and Purpose. The rules in this chapter are adopted by the Medical Examining Board pursuant to the authority delegated by s. 15.08 (5), 227.08, and 448.40, Wis Stats, and further define the practice of medicine and surgery.

Med 15.02 Tattooing and Ear Piercing. The practice of medicine and surgery is further defined not to include tattooing and ear piercing when done for purposes of bodily adornment.
