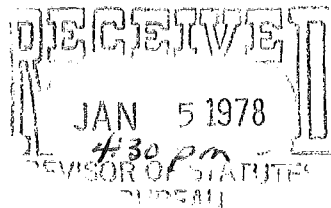

ORDER OF THE DEPARTMENT OF INDUSTRY, LABOR & HUMAN RELATIONS  
ADOPTING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the Department of Industry, Labor and Human Relations by sections 101.01 through 101.20, Wisconsin Statutes, the Department hereby repeals, amends, and adopts rules as follows:

Section Ind 85.07 is repealed.

Section Ind 85.28 is created to read:

- IND 85.28 (1) MASONRY DECLARED TRADE INDUSTRY. The Department hereby declares masonry a trade industry as provided for in section 104.08, Wisconsin Statutes. Anyone working in this industry at a trade recognized by the Department, but at less than the journeyman's level, must be indentured under section 106.01, Wisconsin Statutes.
- (2) EXCEPTIONS. The Department may make exceptions to the operation of subsection (1) where conditions make its application unreasonable.
