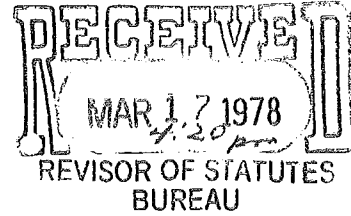

ORDER OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION

ADOPTING RULES

This is an order of the State Superintendent of Public Instruction, adopting rule PI 3.02 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code.

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Department of Public Instruction by Section 115.28 (7), Wisconsin Statutes, the State Superintendent of Public Instruction hereby adopts rule PI 3.02 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code as follows:

That PI 3.02 is recreated as follows:


PI 3.02 Special Licenses. (1) A special license is an instrument limited in time to one year or fraction thereof and to one specific assignment to permit the employment of a legally qualified teacher who does not meet the legal qualifications for the teaching assignment for which a special license is requested. Such license shall expire as of June 30 or earlier of the school year of issuance.

(2) The district administrator of the school district must request such license in writing with full explanation and justification of the need.

(3) The issuance or denial of a special license is at the discretion of the state superintendent.

(4) Renewal of a special license may be granted under certain circumstances which include the satisfactory completion by the applicant of a minimum of 6 semester hours in an approved program between the date of issuance and the date of renewal and may include, but not be limited to, a continued shortage of available regularly licensed teachers. Such studies must be directed toward completion of the deficiencies in the area for which such special license is sought.
