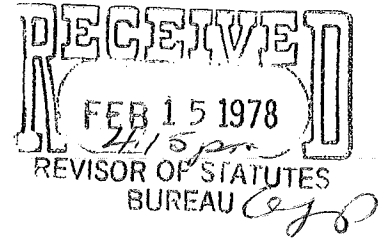


Order of the Employe Trust Funds Board Adopting Rule

Pursuant to authority vested in the Employe Trust Funds Board by sections 15.05 (1) (b), 41.04(2)(e) and Chapter 280, Laws of 1975, and according to the procedures set forth in Chapter 227, Wis. Stats., the Board hereby adopts the following:

ETF 3.03 is created to read:

ETF 3.03 Fee for search of historical records. Employes and employers may be charged an administrative fee of \$5.00 for information concerning an account or record which is not readily available and which requires a search of historical records, either within the department or at the state records center.
