ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD

REPEALING, AMENDING, REPEALING & RECREATING, AND CREATING RULES

Pursuant to the authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board by sections 23.09, 23.11, 29.02, 29.085, 29.174 and 227.014, Wisconsin Statutes, the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board hereby repeals, amends, repeals and recreates, and creates rules as follows:

SECTION 1 - Section NR 10.01 (1) (m) is repealed and recreated to read:

(m) The following described area is established as the Burnett county zone:

All that part of Burnett county lying northerly and westerly of a line beginning at the junction of state highway 70 with the west boundary of said county, thence easterly along said highway to its junction with county highway N, thence northerly along said highway to its junction with county highway D, thence northerly along said highway and continuing northerly along a town road to the south line of section 16, township 39 north, range 17 west, town of Lincoln, thence westerly along a town road to the southwest corner of said section, thence northerly along a town road on the west line of said section and continuing northerly along the west line of section 9, township 39 north, range 17 west to the west bank of the Clam river, thence westerly along the west bank of said river to its intersection with the west boundary of said county.

SECTION 2 - Section NR 10.01 (2) (a) 1. is amended to read:

Kind of animal and locality	Open season (both dates inclusive)	Bag limit
1. In the counties of Adams, Buffalo, Columbia, Crawford, Grant, Iowa, Jackson, Juneau, La Crosse, Lafayette, Monroe, Pepin, Pierce, Richland, Sauk, Trempealeau and Vernon	Beginning on the Saturday nearest October 1 and continuing through January 31	5 each day 10 possession

SECTION 3 - Section NR 10.01 (2) (e) 1. is repealed and recreated to read:

1. All that part of Wisconsin lying southerly and westerly of a line beginning at the junction of state highway 54 and the west boundary of Trempealeau county, thence easterly on said highway to its intersection with state highway 108, thence southwesterly on said highway to its intersection with state highways 27 and 71, thence southeasterly on said highways to their intersection with interstate highway I-90, thence southeasterly on said highway to its intersection with state highway 82, thence easterly on said highway and continuing easterly on state highway 23 to its intersection with state highway 73, thence southerly on said highway to its intersection with state highway 60, thence westerly on said highway to its intersection with state highway 78, thence southerly on said highway to its intersection with state highway 18, thence westerly on said highway to its intersection with state highway 80, thence southerly on said highway to the Illinois state line.

SECTION 4 - Section NR 10.01 (3) (d) is amended to read:

Kind of animal and locality	Open season (both dates inclusive)	Bag limit
(d) Wildcats (bobcats)		
1. Hunting season and trapping in all counties of the state	Beginning on the Saturday nearest November 1 and continuing through January 31	None

SECTION 5 - Section NR 10.01 (3) (f) is amended to read:

(f) Fox, all species

1. Hunting and trapping season in all counties of the state	Beginning on the Saturday nearest November 1 through January 31	None

SECTION 6 - Section NR 10.22 (3) is created to read:

(3) Trapping. (a) Trapping will be allowed by permit only and may be issued on a seasonal basis dependent upon furbearer population levels.

(b) Each year the department shall determine:

1. The number of permits to be issued.
2. The number of animals to be harvested.
3. The time when such trapping may take place.
4. The deadline date for receipt of applications.
5. Such additional restrictions as are necessary to preserve, protect and utilize the furbearing resources on this area.

(c) If applications for permits exceed the number of permits available, random selection shall be used to determine successful applicants.

SECTION 7 - Section NR 11.27 (16) is repealed.

SECTION 8 - Section NR 11.30 introductory paragraph is amended to read:

NR 11.30 Closed area; waterfowl. A closed season is established in the following described areas, and it is unlawful for any person to take, catch, kill, hunt, or pursue in any manner any species of wild animals or birds thereon at any time, except deer during the period established in Wis. Adm. Code section NR 10.01(3)(e) as open gun seasons on deer, and except furbearers, beginning on the day following the closure of the waterfowl season, through the open season for trapping.

SECTION 9 - Section NR 15.01 (7) (b) is created to read:

(b) Township 37 north, range 19 west

Section 2 - W $\frac{1}{2}$ and that part of the SWSE lying west of state highways 48 and 87.

Section 3 - E $\frac{1}{2}$

Section 10 - NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and the N $\frac{1}{2}$ SE

Section 11 - All that portion lying north of Grettum dike road and west of state highways 48 and 87.

SECTION 10 - Section NR 15.02 (29) (b) is repealed.

The foregoing rules were approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on November 17, 1977.

The rules contained herein shall take effect upon publication.
